ORGANIZATIONAL SUMMARY:

The University of South Florida in the sunny Tampa Bay region along Florida's gulf coast consists of campuses in Sarasota, St. Petersburg, and Tampa, which are all thriving, culturally rich cities. The Institutional Effectiveness unit in the Office of Decision Support is a multi-campus support unit that has staff on all three campuses. The Assistant Director for Assessment position, based in Sarasota but supporting all three campuses, facilitates the academic and administrative assessment efforts required by the University of South Florida's institutional accreditor (the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges, or SACSCOC) and the Board of Governors (BOG) of the State University System of Florida, with the twin goals of nurturing continuous improvement and promoting an institutional culture of evidence-based decision making. The unit implemented significant changes in campus wide assessment processes and seeks a team player to help facilitate and evaluate those changes.

POSITION SUMMARY:

The person in this leadership position is an advocate for quality assurance and improvement who understands higher education administration and the unique responsibilities and authority of faculty regarding curricula and the development and assessment of student learning outcomes. In addition to working with faculty, the person in this position will work with professional staff to facilitate the evaluation of academic programs, student support services, and administrative operations. A collaborator with a passion for quality improvement, the incumbent nurtures and supports the efforts of faculty, administrators, and staff across three campuses to ensure high quality assessment plans and the effective utilization of assessment results that foster continuous quality improvement. The incumbent may also support academic program reviews and other quality assurance and improvement efforts. The incumbent will work with those responsible for SACSCOC accreditation and BOG reporting to ensure that assessments are conducted within the guidelines and policies emerging from new federal statutes, accreditation standards, and state requirements. The incumbent will also help ensure three years of academic and student support services assessment data by 2024 and will help draft narrative for the SACSCOC compliance certification in 2024. The position reports to the Associate Director for Institutional Effectiveness who, in turn, reports to the Assistant Vice President for Institutional Effectiveness and Planning, who serves as USF's SACSCOC Accreditation Liaison. The position is physically located on the Sarasota-Manatee campus, but much of the work is conducted via video conference on Microsoft Teams.
