About the Advance Program and the new Advance Thought Leader Program

The QRCA Advance program is elevating professionalism in the qualitative research industry by recognizing those members who demonstrate commitment to the profession by participating in educational programs. The <u>Advance Thought Leader Program</u> is intended to acknowledge QRCA members who actively drive new thinking in the field of qualitative research and create content that is shared in presentation and written formats.

Thought Leader Stars and status are awarded for contributions to qualitative thinking by QRCA members, up to a maximum of 3 stars. Points are earned by creating and delivering presentations on qualitative research topics, by teaching a course at the college or university level, and by publishing articles in QRCA VIEWS, on the QualPower blog or in other peer-reviewed industry publications. Once earned, the stars/status do not expire.

- 1-Star Thought Leader: 2-3 points
- 2-Star Thought Leader: 4-6 points
- 3-Star Thought Leader: 7+ points
